All abstracts must be submitted through the online system on the Congress website and should be prepared in accordance to the instructions below.

Please read carefully the following instructions before proceeding the online submission

GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION OF ABSTRACTS

- 1. Authors should select their presentation preference: oral presentations or free communication. For the oral presentation you have 7 minutes oral presentation during plenary session. For the free communication you have 3 minutes oral presentation in the Exhibition Hall.
- 2. Industrial abstracts will be accepted only for free communication.
- 3. The final decision on the presentation type relies on the Organizing Committee.
- 4. The main author and the presenter must be identified; presenters are requested to register within 5 days after having received their provisional notification of acceptance.
- 5. Abstracts should be submitted via the express form
- 6. Abstracts must be submitted and presented in English;
- 7. Maximum length (body of abstract): 250 words.
- 8. Abstracts must be uploaded in **PDF** format and must be one file only. The maximum size of the file is **1MB**. Please do not include any other information within the body of the abstract, such as the title or name of the authors, since these will be required by the system in other specific fields.
- 9. All accepted abstract submitters will receive confirmation by email. Please do not forget to indicate your correct email address when submitting your abstract, as well as the email addresses of the main author and the presenter.
- 10. Should it be realized, authors agree that their abstract will be published in the congress abstract book (pdf document, downloadable or printed). Please note, it would be published exactly as they have been provided and without any kind of editing;

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- 11. The title should be written in UPPER CASE (capitals). Please keep it as short as possible, clearly indicating the nature of the investigation, and please minimize the use of abbreviations;
- 12. Check spelling and grammar carefully. Direct reproduction from your electronically submitted abstract text means that any errors in spelling, grammar or scientific data will be reproduced as submitted.
- 13. Abstracts should be structured in at least **six sections**, clearly mentioned as such: Title, authors and affiliation Background Aims Methods Results Conclusions
- 14. Please add the total number of the words at the end of the document;
- 15. The 6 best rated abstracts submitted for oral presentation will be invited to give an oral presentation at the Congress and will be nominated for the Uli Petry prize for junior scientists (trainees, Ph.D. students, research students, or research fellows).
- 16. There will be a prize for the best free communication presentation for junior scientists (trainees, PhD students, research students, or research fellows).
- 17. All authors (main author and co-authors) should be listed with their last names (family names) and their first name(s). If there are more than 6 authors on the application the names of the first 6 can be included but the remainder are described as 'et al';
- 18. **One** author must be identified as the presenter; the **presenter** commits to registering as a delegate to attend the congress and present the abstract;
- 19. For authors who submit more than one application, then up to two presentations can be made per attendee. For three or more applications from the same group, two or more applicants must book to attend the Congress.
- 20. Please indicate professional addresses of all authors: name of hospital, unit or laboratory, city and country. No other indications are to be given. Different affiliations will be automatically numbered;
